



PROJECT OF THE YEAR AWARDS

- 1 COMPLETION** | Use of good construction management techniques and the completion of the project on schedule per the date contained in the contract. Address any time extension(s) granted.
- 2 CONSTRUCTION** | Schedule, management & control techniques used during construction. Discuss use of alternative materials, practices of funding that demonstrates a commitment to sustainability. Show sustainability commitment by using a sustainability infrastructure rating system, such as *Envision* or similar tool.
- 3 SAFETY** | Safety performance, including number of lost-time injuries per 1,000 man-hours worked. Demonstrated awareness of the need for a good overall safety program during construction.
- 4 ENVIRONMENT** | Special steps taken to preserve and protect the environment, endangered species, etc., during the course of the project.
- 5 COMMUNITY RELATIONS** | Summary of the efforts by the team to protect public lives and property, minimize public inconvenience due to construction, provision of observation areas, guided tours, or means to improve relations between the agency and the public.
- 6 UNUSUAL ACCOMPLISHMENTS** | Accomplishments under adverse conditions, including but not limited to, adverse weather, soil or site conditions, age or condition of the facility over which there is no control.
- 7 ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS** | Additional conditions such as exceptional efforts to maintain quality control, and construction innovations that resulted in time and/or money savings that you would like to bring to the attention of the project review panel.

NOMINATION PROCESS

A project may be nominated for an award by the Managing Agency, the Consultant, the Contractor or the Chapter. Submittals should include the nomination form, supporting documentation (limited to 20 pages, exclusive of photos and nomination form) that clearly address the seven selection
