Sacramento Chapter of APWA has Scholarships for Graduating High School Seniors

The Sacramento Chapter of the American Public Works Association (APWA) has scholarships available for students interested in pursuing a career in a Public Works related field. Public works are the construction or engineering projects carried out by the state or local government on behalf of the community. Examples include airports, canals, dams, dikes, pipelines, public utilities (water, sewer, and storm drain facilities), railroads, roads, tunnels, and artificial harbors.

Graduating High School Seniors interested in Engineering, Surveying, Construction Management, Math, Science, and all other majors associated with Public Works are encouraged to apply. Awards of up to **\$1,000** will be presented based on qualified applications received from students enrolled in high schools in Alpine, Amador, Butte, Calaveras, Colusa, El Dorado, Glenn, Lassen, Modoc, Mono, Nevada, Placer, Plumas, Sacramento, San Joaquin, Shasta, Sierra, Siskiyou, Sutter, Tehama, Trinity, Tuolumne, Yolo, and Yuba Counties.

The applications are screened for interest in the field of Public Works, academic scholarship, student activities, honors, etc. The top-ranked applicants are invited to a personal or telephone interview with the Chapter Scholarship Committee, if necessary. The final selection of scholarship recipients is made by the Committee after the interviews have been completed.

Scholarship Applications will be distributed via high school email lists and are posted online at <http://sacramento.apwa.net/>. The submittal package consisting of an Application, a Personal Statement (500 words maximum), and current transcripts (or other acceptable record of grades) should be completed and **must be submitted electronically via email**. The submittal package shall have a date stamp no later than **April 14, 2023** and should be sent to the following email address:

Winners will then be invited for a formal presentation and announcement. Scholarship recipients will be welcomed at the event as guests of the Chapter.
